Conyers Mill Celebrates 30 Years of Excellence

This month, we celebrate the 30th anniversary of Pratt's first 100% recycled paper mill in Conyers, GA. This mill set the stage for the growth of our now multi-billion dollar company. Production totals in the mill have grown over the years from 560 tons of paper per day when it opened to 945 tons per day now. The mill even hit a milestone in October by reaching 10 million total tons of paper since it opened!



This production would not be possible without the many employees at the mill. Today, we have 145 people at the mill making 100% recycled paper...seven of whom have been part of the team since day one!
