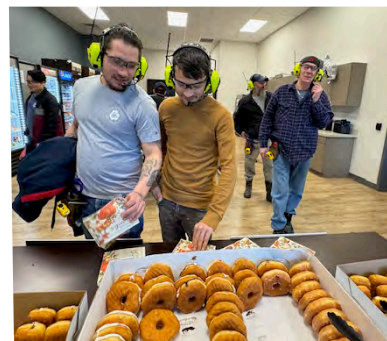
## Employee Appreciation Day
