Family Fun Day at Stone Mountain

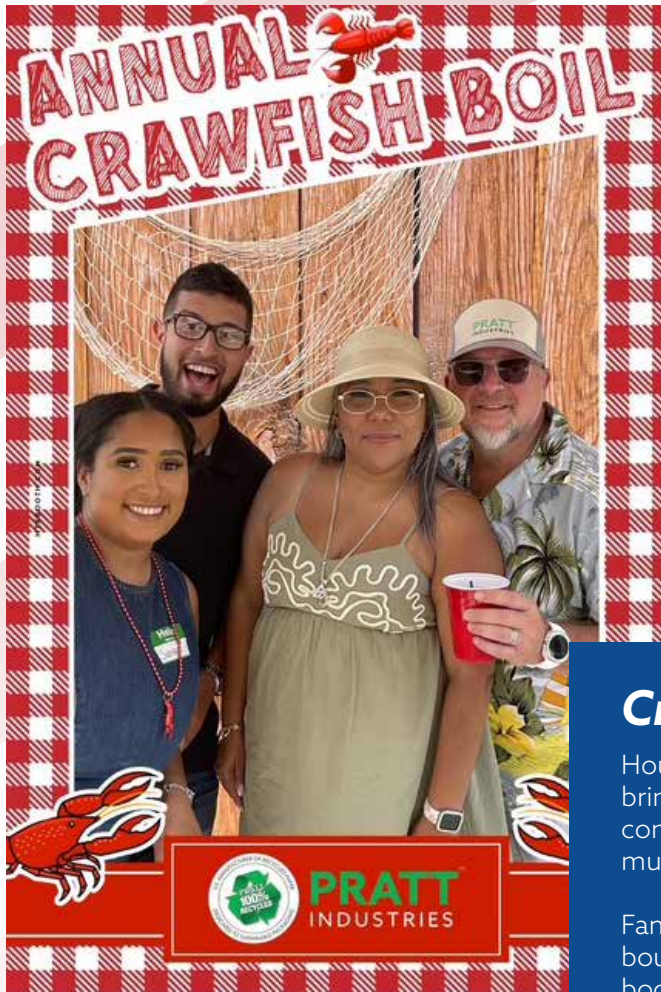
