It is fully stocked with critical survival and communication gear, including first aid kits, megaphones, radios, flashlights, and the official Emergency Action Plan (EAP). By utilizing the posted facility maps and floor plans, the ERT can efficiently divide the building into zones to conduct thorough sweeps, ensuring every employee is accounted for and no one is left behind. With essential contact information for emergency services and medical centers displayed for immediate reference, the board ensures that life-saving resources are always within arm's reach when they matter most.
