Strain & Sprain Prevention MONTH

Situational Awareness Tip: Pivot, don't twist while lifting. (Noise over toes)
Keep loads close to your body and in your power zone.
When lifting heavy/awkward loads, ask for help!
Stretch and loosen your muscles prior to lifting.
